What should I write in a card?

Be as creative as you'd like, but remember, the degree of illness for patients will vary, so it's important that what you write stays cheerful and positive. Some suggested greetings include, "Best wishes," "Thinking of you," or "Have a nice day." Stay away from phrases like "Get well soon" and "Hope you're feeling better," as it might not be appropriate for all patients. Be sure to include a message of "Happy Holidays" as the cards will be distributed for the holidays! Please refrain from using any religious quotes.
